

Pine Agility Dog Sports Vaccination Policy

All dogs entering the grounds of Pine Agility Dog Sports must have immunity against Parvovirus, Distemper, Hepatitis and Canine Cough if they are to remain on these grounds and/or participate in any of the following classes or activities:

- Obedience, Agility, Disc, Motivation and Control.

We will accept any of the following:

- A vaccination certificate detailing evidence of a C4, C5 or C7 vaccination given in the last 12 months.
- Vaccination certificates detailing evidence of a C3 vaccination + Canine Cough given in the last 12 months.
- We accept tri-ennial vaccinations for C3 and C5 accompanied by a Canine Cough vaccination administered annually.
- We will accept Titre results for Parvovirus, Hepatitis and Distemper. These must be accompanied by a letter from the Vet stating the diseases the dog has been tested for, if the dog is immune and when they should be re tested. These members are still required to provide evidence of annual Canine Cough vaccination.

All Vaccination certificates should include the following information:

- Dogs Name and date of birth or age
- Breed or description if mixed breed
- Owners name and address
- Vet's name and signature
- Clinic Name and address
- Details of the vaccination given - stickers from the vial of vaccine are preferred
- Date of vaccination
- Date next vaccination is due

All new members must provide evidence of current vaccination before participating in any activities and/or classes.

No exceptions will be made.

Memberships are renewed annually at the beginning of the financial year. It is the responsibility of members to provide evidence of their dog's current vaccination at the time of membership renewal and as subsequent vaccinations are administered.

Anyone bringing a puppy under 18 weeks of age on to the grounds should ensure the puppy has had age appropriate vaccinations. The member will produce evidence of vaccination if requested to do so and understand they have their puppy on the grounds at their own risk.
